## BASE SIX CODE

How to use this chart to make your own color code:
Choose a color for each of the digits 0 through 5 .
Then give each letter the two colors for its number.
For example if 0 is red and 1 is blue and 2 is yellow, A would be red and blue, and B would be red and yellow.

Fill out the whole chart and then you will have a color code you can use to write messages. Since this is base six, you only need 6 colors.
